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Lights

Priority 1: Lighting for audience visibility

Priority 2: Lighting for audience focus (dark house, bright stage, followspot, etc.)

Priority 3: Lighting on sides of stage, footlights, backlighting, etc. to help execu-

tion of juggling.

Sound

Microphone: Thom travels with his own professional wireless microphone, reciever, and headset with both 1/4" and XLR outputs, and are battery powered.

Music: This show uses prerecorded songs. A sound technician must be on hand

to play songs from a CD player (venue supplied) or iPod (artist supplied.)

Output: A basic mixer and speakers are needed for the entire audience to under-

stand the Thom's verbal comedy.

Stage

Basic: 10' ceiling, 6" raised stage, 10'x6' stage space.

VIP: 20' ceiling, 2' raised stage, 30'x30' stage space, wings to left and right.

Thom can also play in the round, but need to know in advance.

Backstage

Security, privacy, restroom, drinking water, and light snacks. High ceilings, backstage acess, wireless internet, and electricity a plus.
